Velociraptor

The Velociraptor was a predator feeding on other small animals and smaller plant eating dinosaurs. At 2 meters long and around a meter tall it was a fairly small dinosaur but very fierce! It had razor sharp teeth and sickle shaped claws.

The Velociraptor could run up to 40mph (60 km/hr) and hunted in packs
